2006 National Community Reinvestment Conference

The conference will be held March 20-22, 2006, at the Green Valley Ranch Resort located in Henderson, Nevada, which is part of the Las Vegas metropolitan area. Come out and join us for two and a half days of learning, sharing, and networking with your fellow financial services industry peers, community development professionals, and federal banking regulators from across the country. Training tracks have been designed to help address some of the key training needs of insured financial institutions in a rapidly changing environment.
