Dear Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer:

The annual OTS West Region **Seminar for Thrift Financial Managers** will be held at various regional locations in September. This seminar is designed for chief executive officers, chief financial officers, controllers, or others responsible for accounting and financial reporting. The agenda focuses on various technical accounting issues, regulatory capital standards, Thrift Financial Report (TFR) guidelines, and current “hot” topics.

This year’s meetings will be held on September 11 in Los Angeles, California; September 16 in Denver, Colorado; and September 18 in Seattle, Washington. Note that the Los Angeles meeting has been scheduled for the day before the respective Town Meeting. Information on the West Region Town Meetings was previously provided in Regional Bulletins 08-02 and more recently 08-07 which provided specific logistical information.

Also note that each meeting will have a speaker from the Chief Accountant’s office in Washington, D. C. This year, OTS Chief Accountant Jeffrey (Jeff) Geer is scheduled to speak at the Seattle meeting.
