My name is Tom Harwell and I am Vice President of compliance with Fiserv/MortgageServ in South Bend, Indiana. We are a service bureau and provide the data related to mortgage loans to our clients so they can complete the TFR. I have just read that comments are due by October 3rd, 2000. I was previously told that we would have a final definition of the requirements by the end of September. I had a conversation with a representative of the OTS and was told that now the final requirements may be available by the middle of October but may not be complete. The draft documentation as published in the Federal Register indicate major changes to our computer systems in order to comply. The timing for these changes cross over end of year which is a very busy time.

My request is that the requirement for the new reporting format be delayed.
We need 6 months from the time that final specifications are published.
